

New Special Events Policy Passed by Wetaskiwin City Council

(Wetaskiwin, Alberta) – A new special events policy was passed by Wetaskiwin City Council at their regular April 23, 2018 Council meeting.

Special Events Policy No. 2700 ensures that all third party entities planning public events on City of Wetaskiwin property meet with the Community Development department and receive an event planning package and application. Applications will be evaluated for the size and duration of the event, site plan, food vendors, and safety or security needs.

“Home-grown community events are an integral part of increasing Wetaskiwin’s pride and prosperity,” said Jennifer Fossen, Manager of Community Development. “This new policy ensures that we have the opportunity to work with each person or group to help ensure their event is a success.”

For block parties open to the public, a minimum of five business days must be given prior to the event. For events with a planned attendance of less than 1,000 patrons, an event application must be submitted to the City a minimum of 60 days prior to the event.
