

Manluk Industries Inc. awarded naming rights for Wetaskiwin's Regional Aquatic Facility

(Wetaskiwin, Alberta) – Wetaskiwin City Council awarded the naming rights for the Wetaskiwin Regional Aquatic & Fitness Centre to Manluk Industries Inc. at their May 13 meeting.

Manluk Industries, a local firm, offered over one million dollars in a combination of cash contributions and gifts-in-kind in exchange for the naming rights to the new facility, which will now be called the **Manluk Centre: Wetaskiwin Regional Aquatics & Fitness**.

"This is a great example of a community business investing in the community they call home", said Kevin Lucas, Director of Community Services with the City of Wetaskiwin. "I thank Manluk Industries for their generous funding in support of our world-class regional aquatic facility."
