



## PEACE CAIRN RELOCATION

Sealed Tenders, clearly marked as to content, will be received by the **Engineering & Development Services Department, 4705 - 50 Ave, Wetaskiwin, AB T9A 0R8 up to 2:00:00 pm hour's local time on Thursday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019**, for the City of Wetaskiwin – Peace Cairn Relocation. The time will be conclusively determined using the National Research Council of Canada Webclock at [http://time5.nrc.ca/webclock\\_e.shtml](http://time5.nrc.ca/webclock_e.shtml).

Tender opening will be open to the public and will be held immediately following the tender submittal deadline. The final results will not be released until a contract has been awarded by the City.

The Work to be undertaken is generally described as: Peace Cairn Relocation in the City of Wetaskiwin. Includes:

- Peace Cairn Relocation from the current location at 4910 – 55a Street to the new location of 5530 – 50 Ave, see details in the Tender form Document section 00 41 00 page 4 to 5.
- Supply and Install concrete pad, surfaces and walkways, see details in the Tender form Document section 00 41 00 page 4 to 5.
- Supply and Install shrub bed, see details in the Tender form Document section 00 41 00 page 4 to 5.

Starting 2:00:00 pm, local time, Thursday, July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019, Tender Documents and Drawings may be obtained from City of Wetaskiwin Engineering & Development Services between the hours of 8:30a.m. and 4:00p.m., Monday to Friday. A non-refundable payment to City in the amount of \$35.00 will be required for each bidder to obtain a set of documents, paper or electronic.

Bidders are completely responsible for ensuring that their bids reach the correct final location prior to the bid submission deadline. Fax, email and other non-hard copy forms of bids or amendments **WILL NOT** be accepted.

Submission of a Tender by the Bidder gives the City the right to require the Bidder to execute the Contract and to perform the Work as set out within the Tender Documents.

The bidder acknowledges and will be willing to accept the role of prime contractor pursuant to the occupational health and safety act requirements and by submission of a bid acknowledges that it has the capability of fulfilling this requirement.
