

City of Wetaskiwin Releases Unofficial 2019 By-Election Results

(Wetaskiwin, Alberta) – Wetaskiwin voters have elected the following candidates into office as councillors for the City of Wetaskiwin—filling the two vacant seats on City Council:

- Joseph Branco
- Gabrielle Blatz-Morgan

The total unofficial election results for each candidate—ordered by number of votes—are listed below. Those elected to the position of councillor are highlighted in yellow.

According to the Local Authorities Election Act, the by-election results become official four days after the date of election. Given that September 15—four days after September 11—falls on a Sunday, the City of Wetaskiwin will be releasing the official election results on Monday, September 16 instead.

Branco and Blatz-Morgan will be sworn into office at the regular September 30, 2019 Wetaskiwin City Council meeting, to be held in Council Chambers at Wetaskiwin City Hall (4705 – 50 Avenue). Their term on Council will end in 2021, which is when all positions on City Council are up for election again.
