

City of Wetaskiwin 2019 By-Election Results Now Official

(Wetaskiwin, Alberta) – The results from the City of Wetaskiwin’s 2019 municipal by-election are now official and can be found in the table below. Those elected to the position of councillor are highlighted in yellow.

The voter turnout for the by-election was 2,003, comprising 21 percent of Wetaskiwin’s eligible voters.

Branco and Blatz-Morgan will be sworn into office at the regular September 30, 2019 Wetaskiwin City Council meeting, to be held in Council Chambers at Wetaskiwin City Hall (4705 – 50 Avenue). Their term on Council will end in 2021, which is when all positions on City Council are up for election again.
