

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Take notice that Council for the City of Wetaskiwin is considering Bylaw 1944-20 to amend Part 6 of the Land Use Bylaw 1804-13 by adding Religious Assembly as a permitted use in the Downtown District Overlay. The purpose of the DDO – Downtown District Overlay is to provide specific district regulations for the downtown core to cultivate a dynamic environment for business and residents while creating a gathering space for community. This district will take advantage of the historical character of the downtown core while encouraging development that does not require large tracts of land.
