



CITIZEN OF THE MONTH AWARD

It is the desire and intent of the City of Wetaskiwin to recognize these exemplary citizens with a CITIZEN OF THE MONTH award, to be presented by the Mayor and Council at the last council meeting of each month. Nominations will be reviewed by a selection panel on the day of the first council meeting each month. Each nomination must meet certain eligibility criteria to be considered.

GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATIONS

○ ELIGIBILITY:

1. Verified present resident of the City of Wetaskiwin.
2. Proven history of exemplary citizenship and contribution to the betterment of the community.
3. Individuals only (including youth, seniors, volunteers, etc.)
4. Must have given personal resources (time, money, non-monetary aid, etc.) resulting in observable improvements to the City of Wetaskiwin and its citizens.

○ NON-ELIGIBLE PERSONS:

1. Current elected officials.
2. Past elected officials for one (1) year immediately following completion of their last elected term.
3. Paid staff.
4. Paid contractors.

- Nominations must be completed and submitted by 12:00 noon on the date of the first council meeting of each month.
