



Wetaskiwin TAXI License 1989-17 Application Checklist

Taxi Company name:

Check marks in the box then continue to the next step.

1. Complete the Wetaskiwin Taxi application form.
2. Complete an RCMP Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check and pay at City Hall
- i) If fingerprints are required, an additional fee of \$25 will be charged and must be paid directly to the RCMP Detachment.
3. Request an Alberta 5 years driving abstract (Active class 1,2,3 or 4) from the registries
4. Submit all required documentation, including a current digital photo of the applicant, and a copy of current drivers license to Enforcement Services.
5. Wait up to 2 business days for a callback regarding approval from Wetaskiwin Enforcement Services.
6. Once approved, proceed to City Hall to make the final payment for the Taxi License. Bring your receipt to the RCMP Detachment to obtain your Taxi Licence.

Congratulations on your yearly up to date Wetaskiwin Taxi License!

Important Notes:

Possible Delays: Any Criminal Code convictions, as well as violations under the Traffic Safety Act, Motor Vehicle Administration Act, or the Gaming, Liquor, and Cannabis Act, may result in delays. Additional business days may be required to cross-reference this information.

Failure to Disclose Records: Failing to disclose any criminal records on the application form may result in delays or disqualification of the application.

Taxi License Requirement: All individuals operating a marked taxi vehicle must possess a valid, active Taxi License. Failure to comply may result in a citation for both the driver and the Taxi Business.

Renewal Notice: When renewing your annual Taxi License, it is recommended to submit your renewal as early as possible to avoid delays caused by increased applications and a potential backlog of RCMP Criminal Record Checks.



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
