



# Regular Council meetings change to Tuesday

New Council also approves boards and committees appointments

**Monday, October 27, 2025 (Wetaskiwin, Alberta)** — Regular Council meetings will now be held Tuesday at 9 a.m. in Council Chambers at Wetaskiwin City Hall.

City Council approved the change to meeting days during its Organization Meeting on Monday, October 27.
